
STRATEGIC INTENT OF SPORTS HUB INITIATIVE

GENERAL RULES (1/2)

COMPETITION

The Maybank Sport Club (KSMB), Central Committee has officially approved the competition Rules and Regulations for each game, and the organising committee will also enforce any regulations that are deemed necessary.

REGISTRATION OF PLAYERS

- All employees of different sectors/regions are allowed to participate.
- Registration of players must reach the Organising Secretariat latest by Friday, 14th Jun 2024. Any late registration will not be entertained.
- Players who are not registered will not be allowed to take part in any game.
- Changes or update of players from the original registration is only allowed to be made in the Team Managers Meeting at 9.00am on Friday, 18 st Jun 2024.
- All Team Managers are required to fill out a "Player Registration Replacement Form" for games participated and sign the form at the Team Managers meeting.

COMPETITION FORMAT

- League One Round of Competition.
- All game will be played in Round Robin format, Winner will be determined against the placing from No. 1 to 3

BALLOTING & COMPETITION FIXTURES

Balloting for all games will be made by the Competition Organising Committee. The previous Champion and Runner-up of each game will be automatically considered as the top seeded.

REFEREE / UMPIRE

A qualified referee/umpire will be appointed to judge the competition.

GENERAL RULES (2/2)

WALK OVER

- Teams that fail to be at the game venue or courts; ten (10) minutes after the game is due to be started will be considered a win without contest to the opponent unless due to a cause that cannot be avoided.
- The officer on duty can award a win without contest only.
- Team that give a win without contest to the opponent will not be allowed to compete and will be fined of RM200.00 (Ringgit Malaysia Two Hundred Only).

CERTIFICATION OF RESULTS



All players are required to verify and confirm the game results.

Compulsory for the Team Manager / Captain to certify the game result by signing the Score Sheet.

JERSEY NUMBER

- For Football, the numbers must be affixed on the back of the jersey. For Netball and Sepak Takraw, the numbers must be affixed on the front and back of the jersey.
 - A player may use only a number in the competition.
- Players who fail to comply with the regulations mentioned above will not be allowed to play in the competition; however, it is subject to the decision of the referee.
- Players / teams who refuse to comply with rules will be placed before the Discipline, Objections and Appeals (DOA) Committee.
